The BuxMont Unitarian Universalist Fellowship is seeking an accompanist to accompany Wednesday evening adult choir rehearsals and Sunday worship services. These duties will range from 4 to 8 hours per week during the summer to 10 to 14 hours per week for the remainder of the year, averaging approximately one quarter time over the full year. The annual pay will be approximately \$7,500 to \$9,000 depending on the specific times served and the candidate's training, skills and experience. The successful candidate will have strong congregational accompanying skills, experience in a wide range of musical styles, good sight-reading abilities, as well as strong solo ability and repertoire to support the worship services. The successful candidate will be comfortable with Unitarian Universalist principles and practices.

BuxMont is a growing congregation of 240 members in Warrington, Pennsylvania. We recently moved to two worship services on Sunday mornings for most of the year, with one service during the summer months. The congregation celebrates its wide diversity of people and beliefs, is active in social justice and has a strong religious education program. The Fellowship has a strong music program which is well-supported by the congregation. In late 2010, the congregation purchased a new Kawai RX5-BLK 6.5 foot grand piano. The congregation loves to sing with enthusiasm and with deep-felt spirit. Musical styles range from classical to contemporary and include world music, jazz, gospel, folk, and rock. The adult choir has 15 to 20 members singing September through June. Other musical groups include an *a capella* men's choir, an intergenerational family choir, an instant choir, and classical and contemporary instrumental ensembles. The Music Committee runs an ongoing concert series, provides informal performance opportunities, and recently presented a 2-hour musical celebrating BuxMont's 50th anniversary.
